

SYMPTOMS

Symptoms caused by NET can mimic those attributable to other, more common diseases like asthma, IBS, or Crohn's. The following represents a list of possible symptoms caused by neuroendocrine tumors:

- Dry Flushing (redness, warmth) of the face and neck
- Diarrhea
- Rapid heartbeat/palpitations
- Damage of the heart valves
- Abdominal Cramping/Pain
- Blood pressure changes (High or low)
- Urgency to defecate
- Unexplained weight loss
- Unexplained weight gain
- Skin rash or discoloration
- Fatigue or weakness
- Joint pains
- Wheezing
- Coughing
- Shortness of breath
- Anxiety
- Swelling in feet and ankles
- High glucose levels
- Low glucose levels
- Heartburn
- Indigestion
- Pain in the chest
- Bowel blockages
- Chronic pancreatitis
